Paul Miller, Metanoia Prison Ministry

Metanoia is the official prison ministry of our denomination. Metanoia is the Greek word for repentance, or change of mind. Paul Miller, his wife Laura, and son Jack were a vital part of the Southside family for seven years while he served as the campus minister for RUF at TAMUCC. He was also very involved in the Kairos prison ministry during those years, and has had a great desire to work with prisoners ever since. Now Paul is the first Regional Director of Metanoia here in Texas.

Metanoia's mission is to reach prisoners for Christ and to teach them how to be His disciples. They have a three-step process in accomplishing their mission: correspondence program, life on life mentoring, and reintegration assistance. Through these three avenues of ministry Paul seeks to enter into the lives of prisoners, to offer them the freedom that comes only through the gospel, and to equip the church to do the same. We are excited to support him in this wonderful ministry.

Gama Pozos, Reach South Texas

Reach South Texas is the church planting network of South Texas Presbytery. It has the goal of planting one church a year over the next 25 years, focusing on the Austin, College Station, Corpus Christi, Rio Grande Valley, and San Antonio areas. The purpose of Reach ST is to provide financial resources to new churches, as well as recruit, train, coach, mentor, and encourage the new church planters.

The first church is planned for McAllen, TX to begin in June 2020. The church planter candidate is Gama Pozos, a former member of the National Presbyterian Church of Mexico and now on staff with Covenant PCA in Harlingen. Please join us in praying for this vital work in the Valley.
